Statutes

By-Laws and Resolutions

NAME

Article 1 - The subscribers to the present do hereby establish an association named: "International Association of Tax Judges".

PURPOSE

Article 2 - The purpose of the International Association of Tax Judges is to promote exchanges of views and experience on matters submitted to Tax Judges, the organization and functioning of such Tax Judges and the Rules of Law applicable to a variety of jurisdictions. Tax Judges shall comprise of Courts, Tribunals or Administrative Bodies, Judges or retired Judges which or who, irrespective of their official title (for Instance Court, Tribunal, Justice, Judge, Adjudicator, Advocate-Generals, Tribunal Chair or Member, or the like) are or were nevertheless empowered to adjudicate, in disputes involving direct or indirect tax assessments.

SEAT

Article 3 - The seat of the Association shall be at Amsterdam, The Netherlands. The seat may be transferred by a two-third majority decision of the Association of Tax Judges membership.

MEANS OF ACTION

Article 4 - In order to achieve its purpose, the Association may initiate, promote or undertake studies on the matters defined in Article 2 hereof; it may circulate or contribute to the circulation of information on the organization, functioning and jurisprudence of Tax Judges to
